



Tracking Domestic Violence Incidents

In an effort to more accurately collect data needed to track domestic violence incidents, the Field Based Reporting (FBR) system now has mandatory domestic violence fields added to the Criminal and Non-Criminal report templates. The previous Domestic Violence and DV Verbal checkboxes have been replaced with a "Yes/No" dropdown field.

With this change, reports currently submitted and under review including older reports due to the Stats backlog, will not be able to be approved. They will need to be rejected back to the original author to correct and resubmit. If you receive a rejection, please correct and resubmit the report immediately. Email notifications will be sent to the reporting and approving officer of these reports when the report is rejected.
